OUT OF DISTRICT TRANSFER REQUESTS & NONRESIDENT STUDENT APPLICATIONS MUST BE COMPLETED AND FILED AT THE LEE COUNTY BOARD OF EDUCATION CENTRAL OFFICE EACH SCHOOL YEAR

The Lee County Board of Education has policies and procedures in place regarding the District school a student shall attend based on the student's address of residence. **Board Policy 09.11 School Attendance Areas** states: "All pupils shall be assigned by geographic attendance zones and will attend the school designated to serve their area of residence.

State Regulations determine the maximum number of students permissible per classroom at each grade level. The school district has always worked with parents to honor transfer requests within the district as long as class size permits. Parents who wish for their child to attend a District school out of their geographic attendance zone must complete an out-of-district application transfer request and place on file at the Lee County Board of Education Central Office each school year. Requests for transfer to another school within the district must be based on physical, psychological, or educational reasons. Family hardship may also be considered in changing school assignment.

Board Procedure 09.11 AP.21 School Attendance Zones/Areas - Maximum Class Size—Request by Resident for Change in School Assignment will be used to determine the order of school assignment. 09.11 AP.21 states: "Students living within the

District will not be permitted to enroll in a school outside their geographic attendance zone/area if the class in which they would enroll meets or exceeds the maximum class size. If these students are enrolled in a class whose membership increases to exceed the maximum class size, they will be reassigned immediately to another class/school, whichever is appropriate. When other factors are equal, date of enrollment will determine order of assignment and reassignment."

Board Policy 09.12 Admissions and Attendance permits nonresident students an opportunity to attend school in Lee County. This policy states: "Pupils whose parent or guardian resides in the District and has custody of the student, or pupils who are legal residents of the school District, or as otherwise provided by state or federal law, shall be considered residents and entitled to the privileges of the District's schools. All other pupils shall be classified as nonresidents for school purposes.¹

Nonresident pupils may be admitted to the District's schools in accordance with Board policy and upon approval of the Superintendent.³ Parents of nonresident students who wish for their child to attend school in the Lee County School District, must complete a nonresident student application and place on file at the Lee County Board of

Education Central Office each school year. Written nonresident pupil contract information shall be kept on file at both the attending and resident districts.
